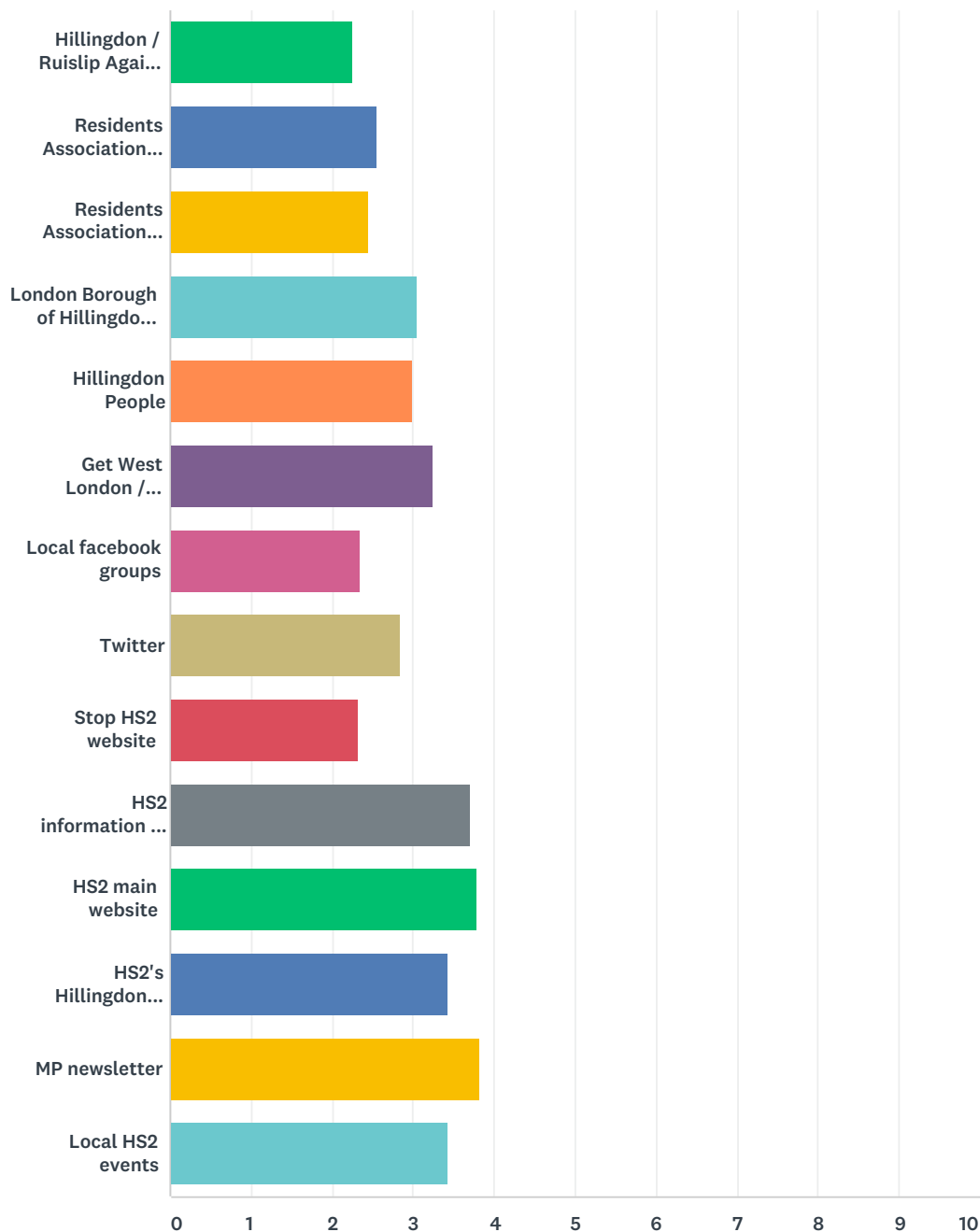

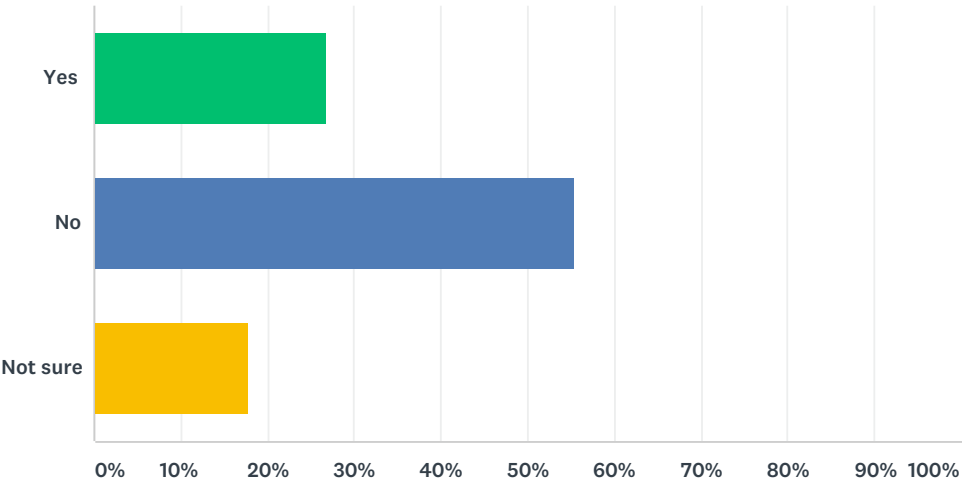

Q5 Would you say you are receiving timely and accurate information about HS2 construction plans which may affect you and your local area from HS2?

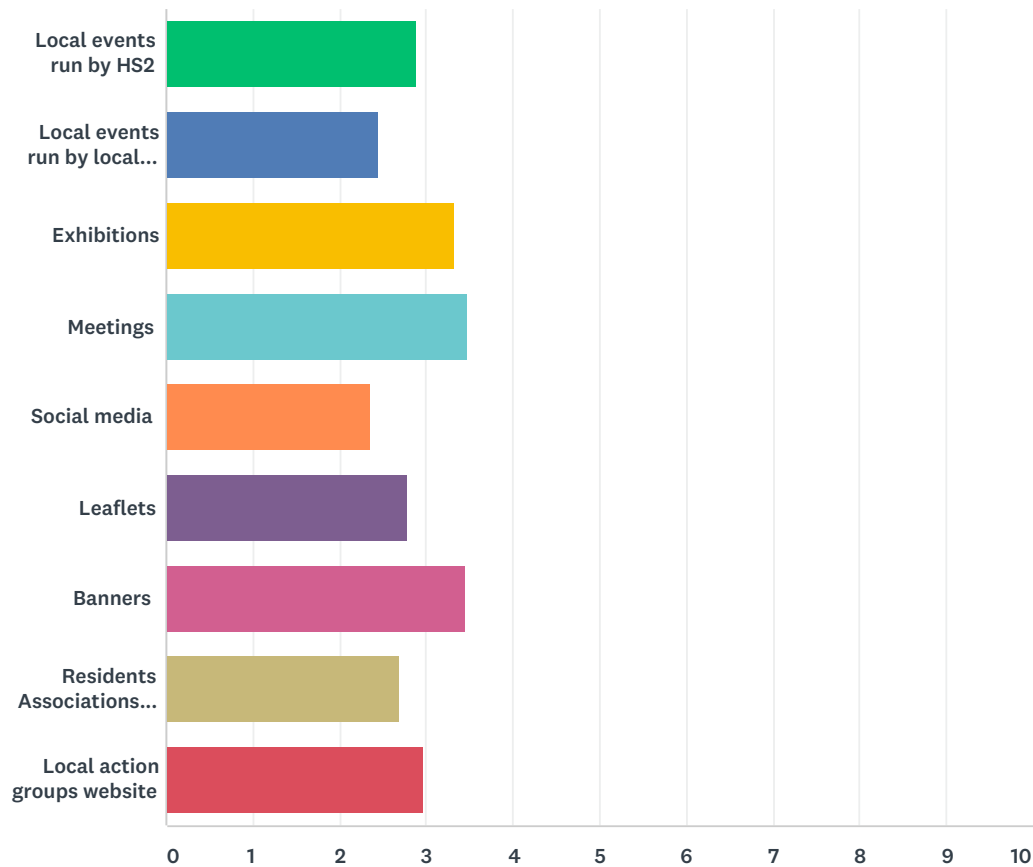

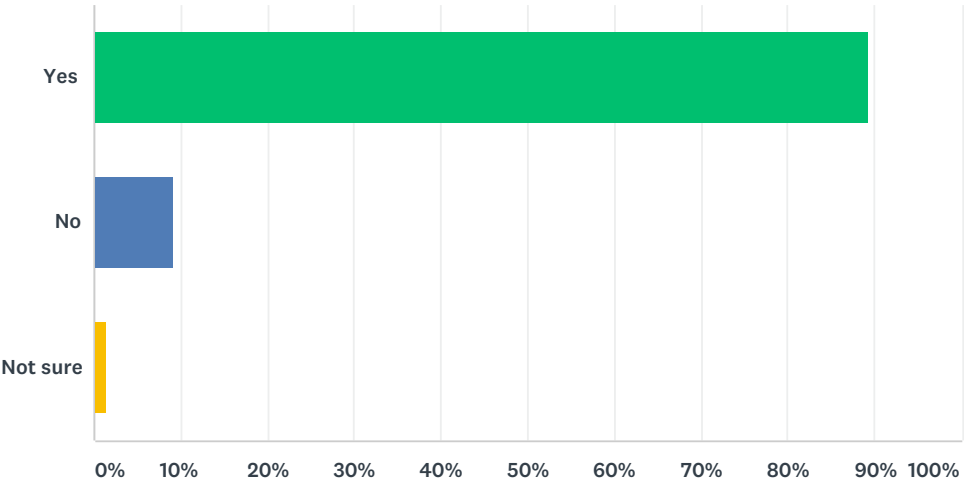

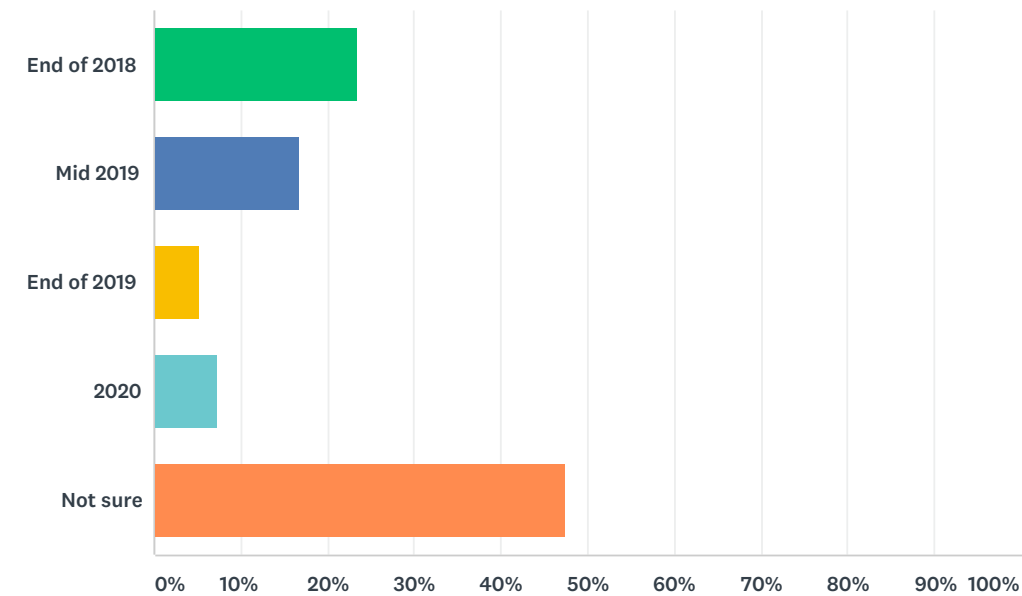

Q8 When do you think main construction is due to start?

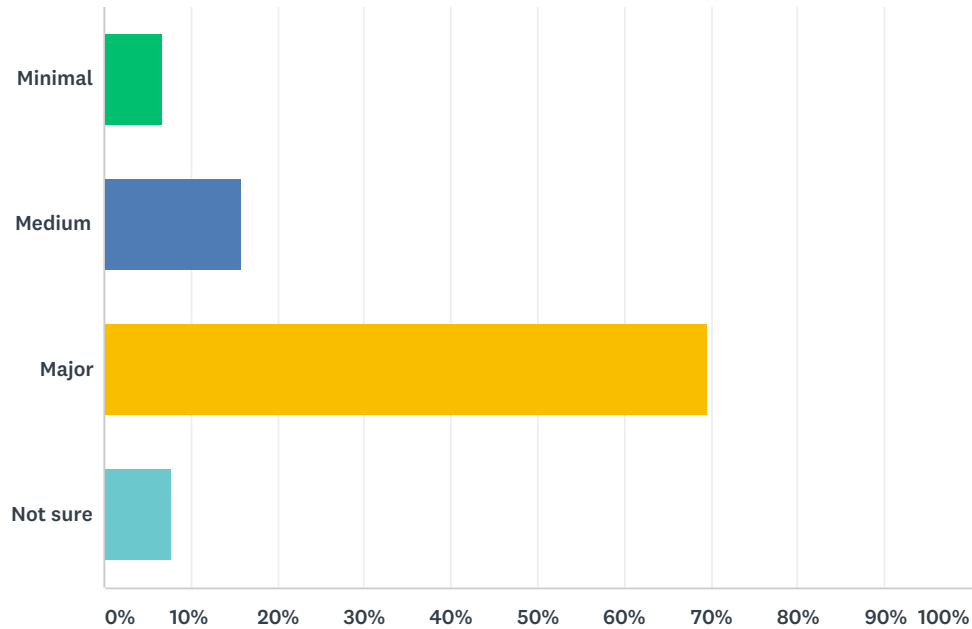

Q9 What impact do you think HS2 construction will have on your daily life?

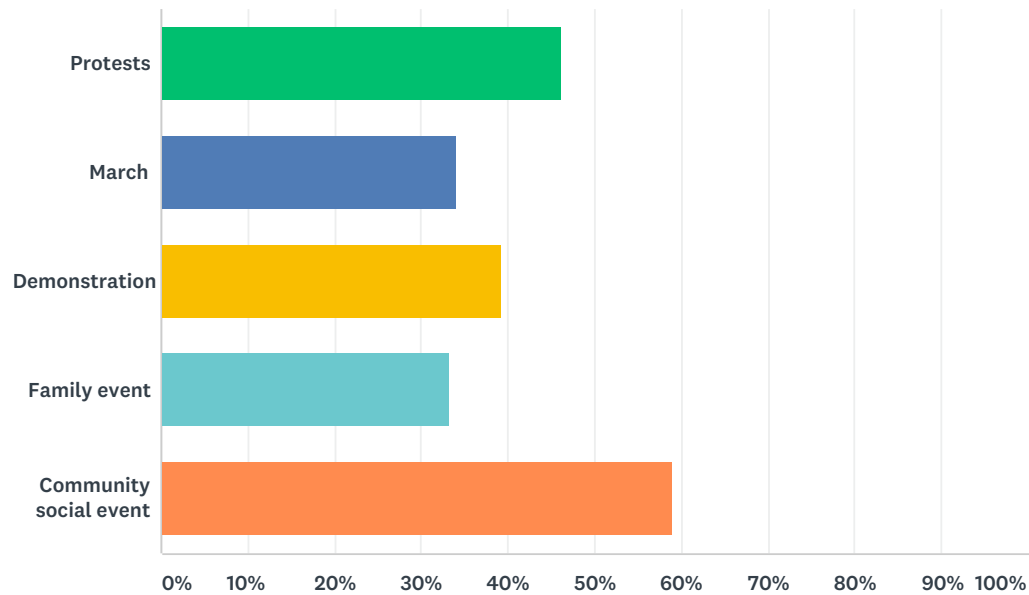
